- D1855/406(2)/17 **Magdalene SEATH** On the 3rd April 1855 in the Parish of Auchtermuchty (406²) as per entry #17. Magdalene SEATH aged 2¼ years at Kinross Road, Auchtermuchty. Daughter of James SEATH (Weaver) and [Catherine ANDERSON](#). Informed by James SEATH (Father). Cause: 5 days ill. Cause not certified. *Buried at Auchtermuchty Churchyard.*
- D1855/417(1)/13 **Robert SEATH** On the 27th November 1855 at 1pm in the Parish of Crail (417¹) as per entry #13. Robert SEATH aged 83 years at Wingfield, Crail. Son of David SEATH (Farm servant dec.) and Catherine ROBERTSON (dec.). No informant stated. Cause: Said to have choked when swallowing food. (No medical attendant). *Born in Kingsbarns, Resident in Crail 12 years, wife Mary PITBLADDO (dec.) Buried in Churchyard of Kingsbarns. Children:- Margaret (60), Jean (58), Euphemia (56), Robert (50), Mary (48), Catherine (44).*
- D1855/426(1)/183 **Janet SEATH (OGILVIE)** On the 22nd December 1855 at 5:00am in the Parish of Dysart (426¹) as per entry #183. Janet SEATH (Agricultural Labourer) aged 80 years at Gallatown. Daughter of James SEATH (Lint Miller dec.) and Isabella ARNOTT (dec.) Informed by Isabella OGILVIE (Daughter). Cause: Palsy (Not Certified). *Born in Auchterderran Parish, resident 25 years. Child - Isabella Ogilvie named (no father named) Buried in Sinclairtown Burial Ground.*
- D1855/441/10 **David SEATH** On the 5th of July 1855 at 4:00pm in the Parish of Kingsbarns (441) as per entry #10. David SEATH (Farm Labourer - Lately a pauper) aged 71 years at Kingsbarns. Son of David SEATH (Farm Labourer) and Catherine ROBERTSON as Informed by William Coutts (Inspector of Poor). Cause: Natural Decay (No medical Attendant). *Born in Kingsbarns, resident there since infancy. Buried at Churchyard of Kingsbarns.*
- D1855/441/6 **Catherine SEATH** On the 28th March 1855 at 5:10pm in the Parish of Kingsbarns (441) as per entry #6. Catherine SEATH (Agricultural Labourer - Pauper) aged 74 years at Kingsbarns. Daughter of David SEATH and Catherine ROBERTSON. Informed by Ann Stevenson and James Murphy. Cause: Gradual Decay (No medical attendant). *Born in Kingsbarns, Buried at Kingsbarns.*
